



How we work.

After you log on and create an Account, the information you provide will be verified by US Paws.

Then you will be given a unique ID number. That number will always be associated with your pet.

A US Paws engraved stainless steel tag will be mailed to your shipping address. This tag has on it that unique ID number. You should immediately attach that tag securely (with hook provided) to your pets collar (dog, cat..), cage, (bird, pocket pet), or affixed to aquarium.

Your account information is only available to you and the information viewable by Emergency Personnel and public is solely at your discretion.
